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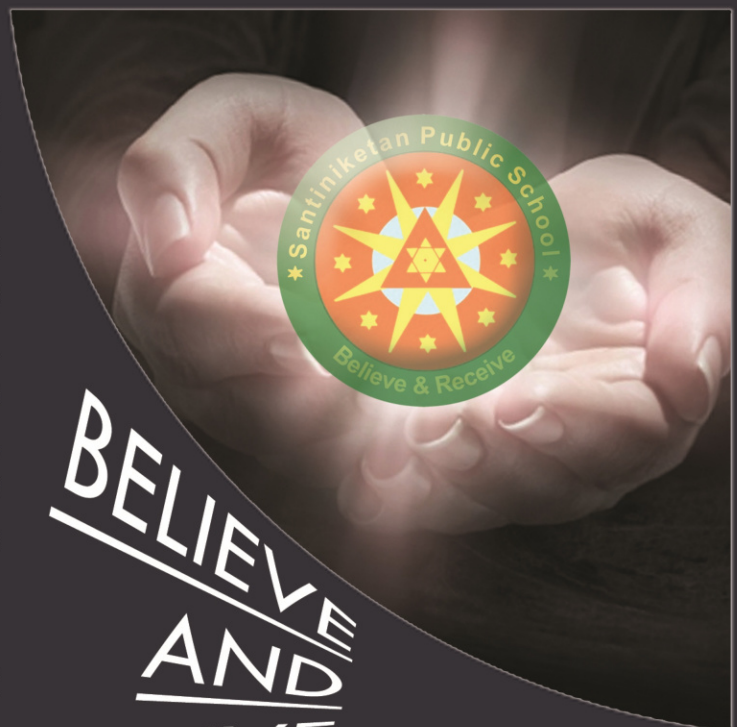


SCHOOL'S MOTTO

SCHOOL - INFRASTRUCTURE

DIGITAL CLASS ROOM

One of the Unique facilities that the school offers is the Digital Learning Classes. Electronic Media is used to encourage learning through both visual and audio media. The school is equipped with smart classes in all the rooms including the library.



MATHEMATICS LAB:



Mathematics Laboratory can be used as an effective tool to create passion towards Mathematics among the students. Students learn and explore mathematical concepts through a variety of activities using different materials. These activities help the students to explore, to learn and to develop interest in Mathematics. It also enables the teacher to demonstrate, explain and reinforce mathematical ideas by using objects, models, charts, graphs etc

COMPOSITE LAB:



The Composite lab caters to the primary and middle section of the school. Students have an easy access to the different instruments and model under the supervision and expert guidance of teachers. The Primary children get access to the Lab by taking the specimens to the lab. Experiments are done in the Classrooms. The school has a spacious Composite Lab with all the facilities. The Laboratories are equipped with the most modern instruments and Teaching Aids suitable for the students of Classes 4 to 10.

COMPUTER SCIENCE LAB

The computer labs have the latest Pentium based multimedia machines for providing hands on experience to students from Nursery to XII. 40 Students can use the lab at a time.

Computer Aided Learning packages are specially designed to make learning more interesting. Smartboards installed in each class emphasizes digital learning which makes learning more interesting. Training programmers are organized for teachers to make them updated with the latest development.



PHYSICS LABORATORY

Our state-of-the-art Physics laboratory is equipped with modern equipments to help the students learn the concepts of Physics with experiments. It is designed to give practice of taking measurements, analyzing data and drawing inferences while the students experiment.

The lab is quite spacious and very well ventilated to ensure proper availability of light in it. Each of the laboratories can accommodate 32 students conducting experiments in groups of two depending on the experiment at hand.



CHEMISTRY LABORATORY

Our chemistry lab is well equipped with chemicals and other apparatus to cater to the needs of all the students up to class 12. Students start using the chemistry lab from class 6 onwards. They show great enthusiasm in using chemicals and perform hands on experiments. The lab has an excellent safety system with fire extinguishers and water facilities



BIOLOGY LAB

Our school boasts of a highly equipped and well-stocked biology laboratory. The laboratory provides the students with all sorts of facilities, The laboratory is quite spacious. The lab consists of simple and compound microscopes for the students to focus and study slides. The laboratory is well supplied with chemicals, and equipped abundantly with thermometers and other apparatus for students to carry out their experiments. All our Science labs are attached with spacious classrooms with smart boards at-



The School library has a wide range of books which include fiction, poetry, prose, philosophy, magazines, comics and newspaper.

The library has a reservoir of audio and video cassettes. It also includes a good collection of CD's and DVD's and other visual aids which aims at the growth of the students and develops self esteem.

In addition to this there are separate seating arrangements for the kindergarten and primary students.

Computerized issuance and return of books to students and staff members is also available.

DINING HALL - LUNCH

The school offers lunch for all the students of Classes LKG to 8. A well prepared menu has been framed keeping in mind the health of the children. The students are taught not to waste food and water. The school also has RO water facility.

6. Boiled Corn: STD LKG to 5 half cup. STD 6 to 8 full cup.
7. Badam: 3, Raisins: 3 Pistas: 3, Figs - 2.



TRANSPORT

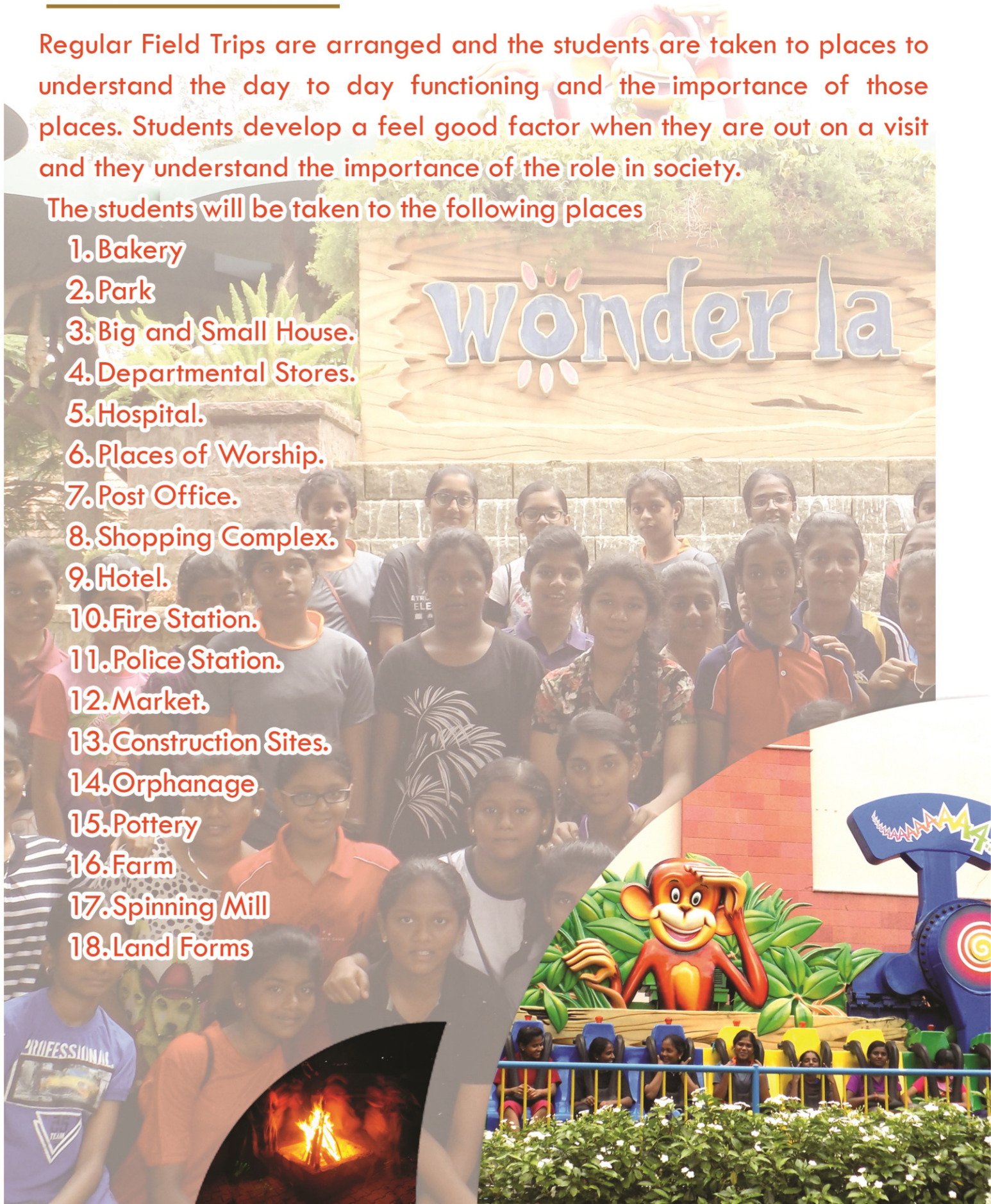
